Regulation G.50(b): Non-disclosure of the contents of a study

- (i) Where part or all of the contents of a doctoral study must remain confidential, the supervisor will be required to submit an application to the Departmental: Postgraduate Committee setting out the grounds for such a request and indicating the duration of the period of confidentiality. This period would normally not exceed 2 (two) years.
- (ii) The Departmental: Postgraduate Committee considers the application and either refers it back to the supervisor, or approves it and submits it to the Faculty: Postgraduate Committee.
- (iii) In the event of a dispute between the supervisor and the Postgraduate Committees a written appeal can be made to the dean. The decision of the dean is final.
